


WORLD WAR II FACTS

P-38 LIGHTNING

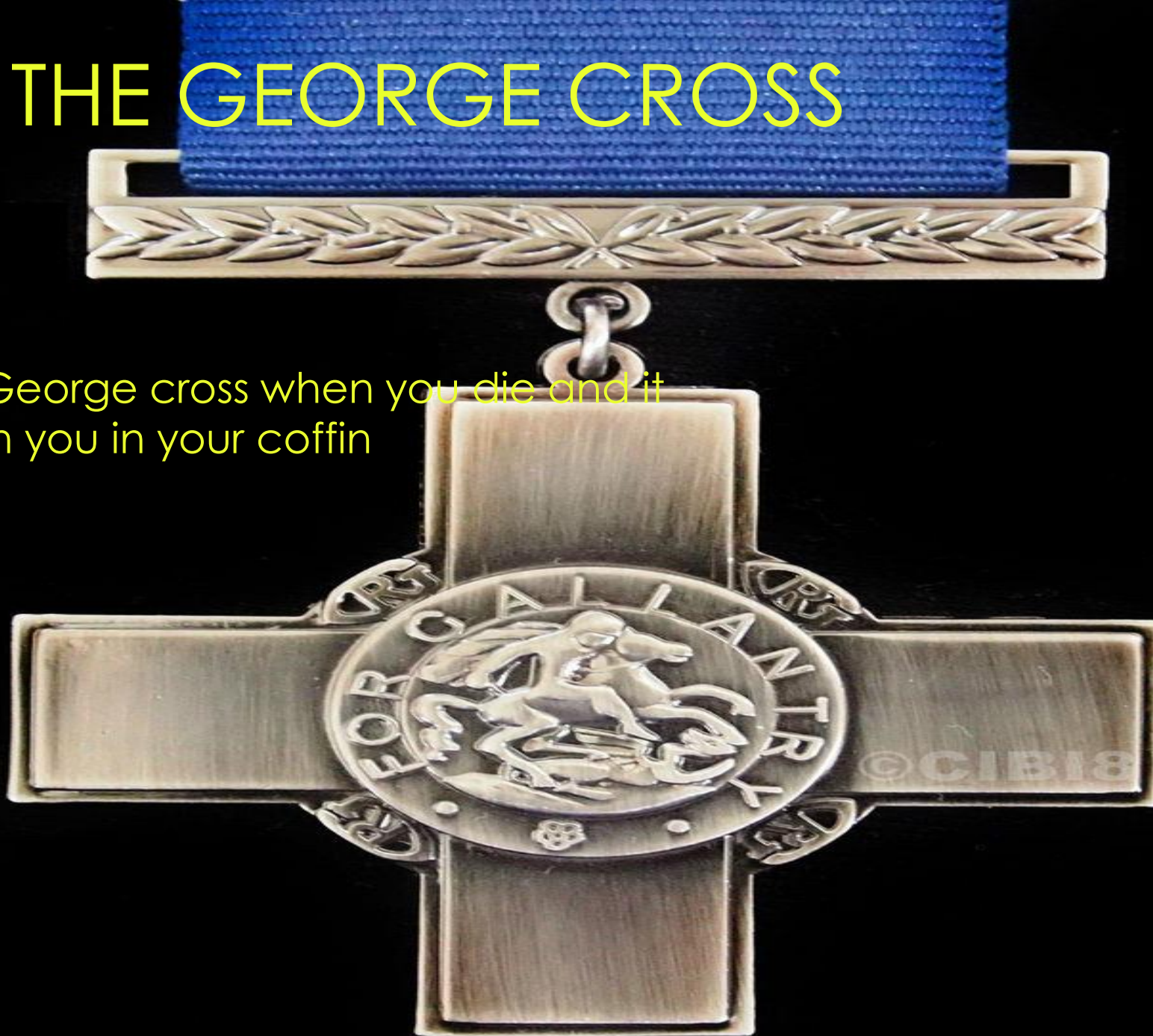
P-38 was the best plane for to us in are army because it had long range shooting and was more quicker at dropping bombs.

THE LEANING TOWER OF PISA COMPLETED IN 1372, THE LEANING TOWER OF PISA IS ONE OF THE MOST RECOGNIZABLE STRUCTURES IN THE WORLD. ONLY PISA'S CATHEDRAL AND BAPTISTERY ARE OLDER THAN THE TOWER IN THE FAMOUS ITALIAN TOWN'S CATHEDRAL SQUARE. DURING WORLD WAR II, THE TOWN FOUND ITSELF UNDER GERMAN CONTROL. THE TOWER WAS USED AS AN OBSERVATION POST – A PERFECT LOCATION GIVEN THE FLAT, COASTAL TERRAIN SURROUNDING PISA.
