

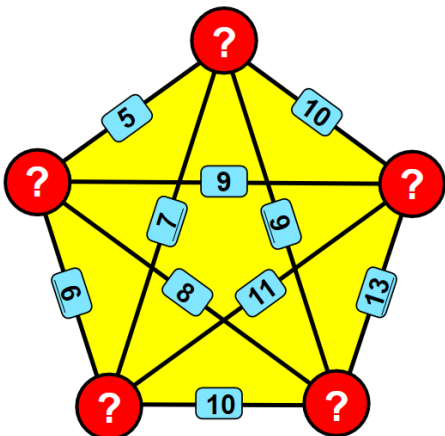
EYFS (Nursery and Reception)

LKS2 (Year 3 & 4)



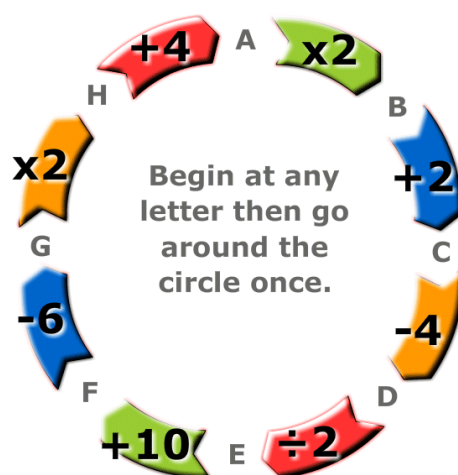
The numbers on blue shapes are the sums of the two hidden numbers on red circles at the ends of the lines. What are the hidden numbers?
