Purpose	To further our studies in history on the Victorian period
Activity	During this day, the children will participate in a 'Victorian Wash day', where they will explore, using real museum objects, how the Victorians did their clothes washing. They will consider the effort involved and how machinery, through time, has changed and automated the process. Furthermore, Year 5 will ride on a steam train, learn how transport has changed through history (especially during the Victorian period).
