Fascinating Facts

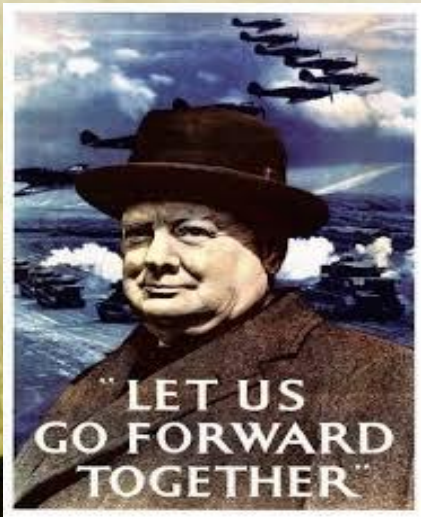
