KS1 (Year 1 & 2)

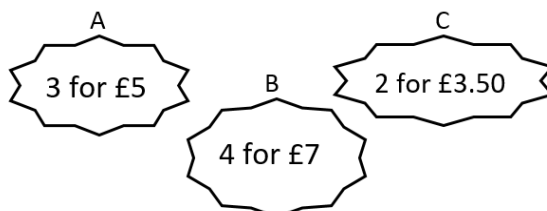
Count up the totals for each tally then answer these questions:

Upper KS2 (Year 5 & 6)


