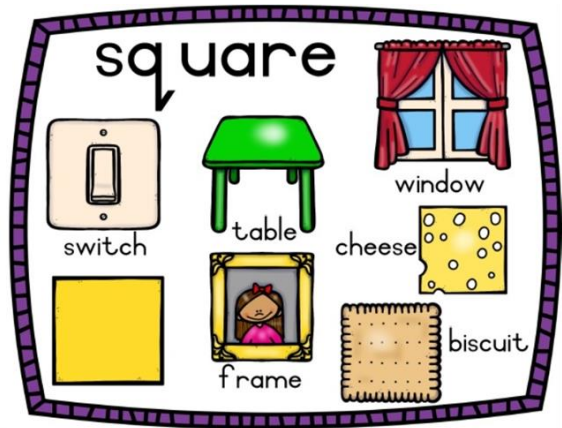


EYFS (Nursery and Reception)
