### Dates

Nursery, Reception, Y1 and Y2	Wednesday 19 <sup>th</sup> September (3.30 – 4.30pm)
Ys 3, 4, 5 and 6	Thursday 20 <sup>th</sup> September (3.30 – 4.30pm)

### Directions

No advance confirmation of attendance is necessary.

On the day, instead of collecting your child at 3.15pm, please let your child's teacher know you are staying for the evening. They will then send your child to the supervised activities in a different part of the school. If you have more than one child at the school, **please do this for them all.**

Entry to the curriculum evening is directly through the respective classroom door at 3.30pm, which will give the teachers a few minutes to set up.

After the meeting, children will be brought back to the classrooms.

### Please note

- Children who attend Cathedral School cannot stay with parents during the meetings - they must go to the supervised activities.
- Babies and children under nursery age who do not attend Cathedral School may accompany parents, on the understanding that parents will take them out if they become noisy.
- Children in Year 5 and Year 6 who have permission to walk home unsupervised will be dismissed as usual at the end of the day, but they do have the option of joining the supervised activities at their parents' direction. Please ensure the children are clear about their going home arrangements.
